Please see the attached document, in which your client states they created [breakingcodesilencelawsuit.com](https://breakingcodesilencelawsuit.com) website at your direction.

Additionally, Ms. McNamara is actively evading service. She has been instructed to report to the sheriff's station and has not complied. Given your involvement in directing the creation of these defamatory websites, will you accept service on her behalf?

These websites constitute a direct violation of the Temporary Protection Orders issued in Washington to restrain Ms. McNamara from continued harassment. Please confirm whether you will accept service to facilitate compliance with the court's directives.

Dear Mr. Tate,

I am writing regarding your client, Katherine McNamara, and the website located at <https://wwasurvivorstruth.com/jenna-bulis-part-1/>. The website contains defamatory and false statements, as well as private records and videos, that specifically target me, Jenna Bulis.

This conduct constitutes harassment, cyberstalking, and retaliation for my previous reports of Ms. McNamara's actions to the FBI and the Lake Stevens Police Department. Additionally, Ms. McNamara was instructed during the protection order case I pursued against her to cease such behavior, as it constitutes defamation and harassment under Washington State law.


I demand that your client immediately remove all content related to me from the aforementioned website and any other platform under her control. Furthermore, Ms. McNamara must cease any further harassment, including cyberstalking or publication of defamatory materials targeting me.

Should this matter remain unresolved, I will be forced to consider all available legal options to address Ms. McNamara's ongoing conduct.
